# Core duties and responsibilities

- Providing scientific, administrative and financial supervision of the Institute of Forensic Medicine, adhering to high quality standards, as well as personnel management
- > Conducting internationally acclaimed scientific research and providing international representation in at least one of the following areas: diagnostic forensic imaging, clinical forensic medicine, or molecular forensic pathology
- > Acting as a judicial assessor and providing forensic consultations
- Contributing significantly to the development of curricula, lectures and courses, as well as to teaching at university level
- Training younger colleagues for a range of professions, in particular medical doctors and scientists
- > Cooperating with other scientists in research fields represented at the Medical University of Graz, University of Graz and Graz University of Technology within the BioTechMed-Graz research network
- Supporting the shared use of clinical resources and actively contributing to existing and planned future interdisciplinary research centers

#### Successful candidates must have the following qualifications

- University degree in medicine (degree from an Austrian university or equivalent, internationally recognised academic degree as a medical doctor)
- Training as a specialized physician in forensic medicine or an equivalent, internationally recognised field of qualification; several years of experience in this field
- Habilitation (venia docendi) or equivalent, internationally recognised certificate in the relevant field
- Several years of experience as a team leader
- Established reputation as an active member of the international academic community
- > Several years of experience in teaching at the university level, especially in the field of forensic medicine
- > Excellent research and publication record
- Successful record of grant or other third-party funding
- Good knowledge of German and English (oral and written)

## Additional desirable qualifications:

- Record of international research stay(s) abroad
- > Experience in the field of protection for victims of violence, including children
- > Quality management skills
- Demonstrated university didactic skills
- Personnel management skills
- > Skills in gender competence and diversity management

- Willingness to cooperate, open-mindedness and ability to work in teams
- > Systematic and analytical working practices, excellent organisational skills
- Communication and social skills, ability to resolve conflicts

# Organizational Integration of the Professorship

As a University Professor of Forensic Medicine, you will be permanently employed at the Medical University of Graz and will act as the Chair of the Institute of Forensic Medicine. Additionally, you will be expected to actively participate in developing strategic concepts for the future of the Institute of Forensic Medicine. In the future, the Medical University of Graz plans to merge the Institute of Forensic Medicine with the Ludwig-Boltzmann Institute for Clinical Forensic Imaging to form the planned institution: the "Forensicum Graz". If the necessary criteria are met, the option to fill the position as director of the "Forensicum Graz" exists.
