## Appendix I

# General Terms and Conditions for university courses at the Medical University of Graz

### § 1 Conditions for registration

(1) By signing the registration form, the participant declares to have understood the terms and conditions of this General Terms Act and to accept this as binding and valid registration to the course.

(2) The program director is authorized to select candidates according to the admission criteria in the curriculum in a course-specific selection procedure. At least 6 weeks prior to start of the course all the candidates will receive a notice of their acceptance. Applicants who are not accepted and fulfill the curricular admission criteria will be placed on a waiting list according to the order in which they submitted their application and move up in this order if a accepted participant drops out.

(3) The Medical University of Graz (Med Uni Graz) reserves the right to postpone the course due to an insufficient number of participants or for other important reasons or to entirely cancel it. Already received payments of course fees will be refunded in this case.

(4) Likewise, the Med Uni Graz reserves the right to carry out necessary changes with regard to the venue, time and dates, course content and the lecturer (even at short notice). In addition, Med Uni Graz is authorised to make necessary changes to the method of the courses due to force majeure and/or official directives. Changes within the meaning of this paragraph shall entitle neither to a cancellation of registration, nor to a reduction or (partial) refund of the course fees nor to claims for damages.

### § 1a Admission and registration for continuation of studies

(1) Course participants have to register for Continuation of Studies for each semester until the completion of their studies according to § 62 Universities Act 2002. Failing this their course admission will expire according to § 71 (1) no. 2 Universities Act 2002.

(2) According to § 38 (4) HSG, the payment of the students' union fee is a prerequisite for the Registration of Continuation of Studies for the semester in question.

(3) If the programme has not been successfully completed within the maximum duration of study specified in the curriculum, the admission expires automatically in accordance with § 71 (1) no. 6 UG as amended if the maximum duration is exceeded.

(4) Course participants make a request for an Academic Leave according to § 67 Universities Act 2002 to the Study Rector of Med Uni Graz. During the semesters for which an Academic Leave is approved no Course fees are to be paid - except for the students' union fee as mentioned above.

## § 2 Terms of payment

(1) The respective course fee must be received in the account named by the course office at least 8 weeks prior to the beginning of the course.

(2) All course fees are to be understood in Euro and include the course material (scripts, handouts) in electronic or paper form; not included are all consequential expenses such as books, accommodation, travel, food, printing, fees of international money transfer etc.

(3) The course fee is currently exempt from VAT. If it turns out in retrospect that it is subject to VAT, the Med Uni Graz is entitled to charge the tax retrospectively and the participant agrees to the retroactive payment of the tax.

(4) Only upon full payment of the course fee the participant is entitled to participate in the course. The agreement of a payment in instalments is possible with the course management. In any case has the first rate to be paid as stated in § 2 (1). In case of delayed payment the participant is not entitled to participate in the course.

(5) The course fee refers to the duration of the course as mentioned in the respective curriculum. If the course is not completed by a participant within the designated time, the participant will be charged an extended course fee of EUR 500.- for every additional semester required.

## § 3 Terms of Cancellation

(1) Withdrawal free of charge in accordance with § 4 Para. 1 no. 8 FAGG is possible within 14 days after confirmation of admission. A declaration of withdrawal must be made in writing. The date of the postmark or the date of receipt of an e-mail in the course secretariat is decisive. In this case, any course fees already paid will be refunded to the participant.

(2) In the event of cancellation of the course registration by the participant after the above mentioned deadline, a cancellation fee of 50% of the course fee will be charged and due.

(3) In the event of cancellation after the start of the course, the entire course fee will be charged and due.

#### **§ 4 Liability**

(1) The knowledge gained from the course and (later on) applied does not justify any liability claim against the Med Uni Graz.

(2) Liability for damages occurring during the course is excluded to the extent permitted by law. Liability for slight negligence, compensation for consequential damage and financial loss as well as loss of profit and damage arising from claims of third parties is excluded in any case. Each participant is obliged to indemnify and hold Med Uni Graz harmless from such claims.

(3) In the event of theft, loss or damage to items brought to the course, in particular valuables, the Med Uni Graz assumes no liability.

(4) The house rules of the Med Uni Graz and its venues apply in its current valid version. Repeated violation of the house rules or other safety or administrative regulations may lead to exclusion from participation in the course. In this case, the course fee will not be refunded.

#### **§ 5 Copyright Protection**

The content of the course as well as all the teaching and learning materials (such as scripts, electronic media, videos, etc.) provided to the participants are the intellectual and sole property of either the Med Uni Graz or the author and are exclusively for the personal use of the participants. Reprinting that goes beyond the free use of works within the meaning of the Austrian Copyright Act (UrhG) or any other reproduction of the teaching or learning materials is not permitted.

#### **§ 6 Others**

(1) If any provision of these terms and conditions become invalid or unenforceable, the validity of the remaining provisions shall not be affected. An invalid provision shall be replaced by a

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valid one, which comes closest to the objective of the original provision. In case of doubt, the invalid provision shall be replaced by a statutory provision.

(2) Apart from the provisions laid down in writing in these terms and conditions no other agreements have been made. Amendments to these terms and conditions - including the requirement of written form - must be made in writing.

(3) These terms and conditions are subject to Austrian law.

(4) In the event of disputes arising from or in relation to these terms and conditions, the competent court in Graz shall be deemed agreed.
