The official CVs of scientists only show their successes. “Growing up in Science – Graz” takes you on a journey to the behind-the-scenes stories of these CVs.

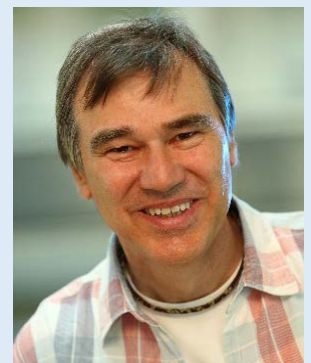
